By the end of the 2006 season, the Allstars had used 108 individual players in six seasons, of whom 75 (or 69%) were called upon to bowl. 51 players were led out to the front-line in the 2006 season itself and all but twelve turned their arm over.

MCD Bovill just misses qualification, at 99 runs, with N Chadwick beneath him on 95 runs. Twelve players have batted but have yet to score a run for the Allstars; only one of these (T Fletcher) has appeared more than once though (appearing twice, in fact). Seven Allstars have appeared but not batted, six of them appearing on one occasion only – the seventh, John Ryan (a 2006 debutant), has so far sat through three matches but never lifted a bat in anger.

RA Eager and DA Halladay have both taken nine wickets each for the Allstars, followed by KJP Toohey and MCD Bovill (ever the bridesmaid it seems) with seven. Four players have taken five wickets (including both Messrs Dyer and Pordes), whilst twenty-three have bowled but taken none. Of these, CV Backus has bowled the most overs (15) without reward, despite only appearing three times as a bowler for the Allstars.

The scorer doubts the veracity of these statistics, showing as they do the skipper in the list. A possible explanation is that the recording of catches (which is haphazard at best) suffers from a statistical anomaly whereby whoever is scoring is so surprised by a catch at mid-on that it is always recorded, whilst others are less reliably noted.
